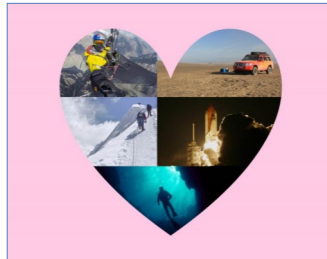
KnO₂weldge 9 leads a student on a fantastic journey to ESA
